"**Shall** — the City of Reno, Nevada be authorized to permanently increase the levy on ad valorem taxes in an amount not to exceed \$0.1684 (sixteen and eighty-four one-hundredths cents) per \$100 of assessed valuation for the purpose of increasing police services including hiring, training and equipping additional police personnel for a total estimated annual value of \$3,500,000?"

**Explanation to Question**

A "**YES**" vote will authorize the City of Reno, Nevada to permanently increase ad valorem taxes to generate funds for the purpose of increasing law enforcement services provided by the Reno Police Department. This increase will generate sufficient revenue to hire, train and equip 88 additional peace officers. For a residence valued at \$100,000, this levy would increase taxes by less than \$59.00 per year.

A "**NO**" vote will prevent the City of Reno from increasing ad valorem taxes for the purpose of improving police services.
